### 2018 LAPTOP DEVICE PROGRAM

## BILLING

School fees are billed annually with statements issued in January. Any additional costs will be charged and statements issued at the end of each school term.

## PAYMENT OPTIONS

From 2018, Padua College has partnered with FACTS Management Company to help the College manage our school fees payment program. Through FACTS, the College has two payment methods:

1. **Direct Debit** (either from a bank account or credit card) commencing January / February 2018  
 There are 4 options for direct debit payments:
  - a. Weekly direct debit payments between January and November 2018; or
  - b. Fortnightly direct debit payments between January and November 2018; or
  - c. Monthly direct debit payments between January and November 2018; or
  - d. Term direct debit payments in February, May, August and November 2018
2. **Payment in Full** – families wishing to pay the annual account – in full will receive a 2% discount on total fees and are to make one payment by 20<sup>th</sup> February 2018

## FEE COLLECTION

The financial operations of the College relies on the prompt payment of fees.

The College also requests that all families sign up to the FACTS payment system via direct debit, which means your payments will be split over the school year February to November and which will offer greater efficiency for the school while providing convenience to families.

Parents unable to make payments prior to the due dates or via FACTS must make arrangements with the Business Manager prior to the commencement of each Semester. Whilst the College is supportive of families in difficult financial circumstances, it is still an expectation that families will make every effort to pay the full fees and that families respond to all communications in this regard.

In cases where reminder notices are persistently ignored or arrangements to meet the arrears are not met, the College will pursue legal action to recover outstanding fees and ongoing enrolment will be reviewed.

Please note that previous payment arrangements cannot be assumed as continuing and must be reviewed annually.

## **VOLUNTARY TOURS**

Where school fees remain in arrears and a FACTS direct debit / payment plan has not been setup, a student will be ineligible to participate in voluntary school tours.

## **WITHDRAWAL OF STUDENT**

The College expects that a minimum of one term's notice be given in writing for withdrawing a student from the school. A full term's tuition fees will be charged should this notice not be given.
