Padua Prize Giving Evening Criteria and Calculations

The calculations for Academic Awards for the Padua Prize Giving Evening are based on cumulative results for the year to date and thus, Terms 1, 2 and 3 will be used to calculate Academic awards. In Years 7-10, where students can change subjects in Term 3, a process of aligning elective subjects is used to determine an overall cumulative so that the criteria for deciding awards can be equitably applied. The criteria for Academic Awards for Prize Night, based on cumulative results year to date are as listed in the tables below.
