College 1:1 Device program

Dear Parents/ Caregivers

As of 2017 the College is 1:1 laptops across the College. This means that current computer rooms will be converted to classrooms and there will be no computers in the library. Specialist areas such as Art and FTV will maintain their current machines until further notice.

If you have chosen **not** to provide your son with a school purchased laptop this will have a number of implications for his study while at the College. These implications are:

- Your son will not have access to printing services here at the College – there will be no computers available in the library or computer rooms for you
- Any new or additional software will need to be purchased, installed and maintained by you (or your son) – we are not currently aware of any changes to the software currently being used by senior subjects
- If for any reason your son's device needs repair, it is expected that he has a working device during that period - it is a College expectation that all students have a working device at all times

Please be aware that if your son is not able to meet assessment deadlines as a result of any of the above mentioned points, consequences for non-submission of assessment as outlined in the student handbook will apply.
