Billing

School fees are billed annually with statements issued in January. Subject Levies and any additional costs will be invoiced at the end of each school term and payment plans updated.

Family Discounts (on Tuition only)

Family discounts are available on tuition fees only (not levies) and are applicable for students attending during 2020: for second student 25% discount, third student 33% discount and for fourth and subsequent students 100% discount on tuition fees.

Payment Options

Padua College has partnered with FACTS Management Company to help the College manage our school fees payment program. Through FACTS, the College has two payment methods:

- **Direct Debit** (either from a bank account or credit card) commencing February 2020 and finishing November 2020 – payment can be made weekly, fortnightly, monthly or by term
- **Payment in Full** – families wishing to pay the annual account in full will receive a 2% discount on total fees and are to make one payment by 20th February 2020

For those families that have previously signed up with FACTS, you will receive a re-enrolment notice via email. This notice will include payment option information for 2020 rolled over from 2019. Once you receive this notice, please login into your FACTS account to check your details and update if necessary. If you wish to change your payment plan option please advise accounts@padua.qld.edu.au.

For new families in 2020, you will receive an invite from FACTS via email with information necessary to enrol, and for more information about the FACTS system their website is www.FACTSmgt.com.au.

Fee Collection

The financial operations of the College relies on the prompt payment of fees.

The College also requests that all families sign up and pay school fees via the FACTS direct debit payment system, which means your payments will be split over the school year February to November and offers greater efficiency for the school while providing convenience to families.

Parents unable to make payments prior to the due dates or via FACTS must make arrangements with the Business Manager prior to the commencement of each Semester. Whilst the College is supportive of families in difficult financial circumstances, it is still an expectation that families will make every effort to pay the full fees and that families respond to all communications in this regard.

In cases where reminder notices are persistently ignored or arrangements to meet the arrears are not met, the College may pursue legal action to recover outstanding fees and ongoing enrolment will be reviewed.

Please note that previous payment arrangements in relation to concessions on school fees are only applicable for one school year and families are required to re-apply for any further concession on fees.

Voluntary Tours

Where school fees remain in arrears, a student will be ineligible to participate in voluntary school tours.

Withdrawal of Student

The College expects that a minimum of one term's notice be given in writing for withdrawing a student from the school. A full term's tuition fees will be charged should this notice not be given.

Absences

No fee deduction is made for any delays in a student returning at the beginning of term or for absence during the term and/or at the end of term.

Laptop Device Program

Laptops provided by the College as part of the General Purpose Levy remain the property of Padua College. If the laptop is not returned either on request or prior to the cessation of enrolment, charges will be applied to the College fee account to recover the cost of the laptop and associated accessories.

The following outlines the approximate cost to parents **where repairs are not covered by Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) or Warranty**. In the event of the repair/replacement cost not being covered by ADP or warranty, the repair will be charged to parents through FACTS.

Where indicated by ** the following prices are indicative only and subject to change based on the type and age of the laptop. Repairs not covered by Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) or Warranty will also incur a labour cost charged by the vendor.
