




### **Acknowledgment of Country**

Inclusive learning is fostered through a comprehensive support network, encompassing Classroom Teachers, Pastoral Guardians, and our LEC team. The team consists of 6 Learning Guardian Teachers, 6 Teacher Aides and 2 Speech Pathologists.

Students transitioning into Year 7 or new students, who require academic support will receive ongoing assistance through an assigned Learning Guardian. Depending on the specific needs, Ms. Marina Bonello serves as the Year 7 academic Learning Guardian.

Transition meetings for students with Personalised Support Plans are taking place this term to facilitate smoother transitions for 2024.

# It is completely normal to feel anxious



### Things to Know About the First Day

### Weeks 1 to 3 of Term 1

- The first three (3) weeks of Year 7 have been designed as an orientation block.
- Using a gradual release model, students will be introduced to what learning in the Middle Phase looks like.
- Focuses include:
  - Learning dispositions
  - Character strengths
  - Notetaking skills
  - Middle Phase Homework
  - MyPadua Familiarisation





# Year 7 Camp Weeks 2 & 3, Term 1

- Focus on developing relationships in the boys' new core classes.
- Students will attend camp in their Core Classes with their Core Teachers.
- Begins the 'becoming' focus of the Middle Phase.

# 4 Steps to Homework Success



 Revision of the work covered in class that daincluding reviewing the Learning Goal and Success Criteria of the lesson.



Set Homework given that day by the teacher.





 Reading ahead and Wider reading - read ahead in the textbook to get a start on the next topic or do some independent reading related to a topic of study.

# There is <u>always</u> homework in the Middle Phase

- The Middle Phase Approach to Homework sees the students progressing through four (4) stages of homework
- This approach is consistent throughout the Middle Phase









# Beyond the Bell Learning

- A range of options that extend the pedagogy from classroom learning into the home learning environment,
  - Maths MathSpace
  - Science & HPE STILE
  - English/HASS/RE Education Perfect
- Highly interactive and multimodal.
- Can provide students with real time feedback.





## Padua College Values Reading

- A 2022 study by Australia Reads found that 89% of students (aged 6-17) agreed that they enjoyed and engaged in reading when they were able to pick what to read.
- Students have access to a wide range of resources for reading,
  - MyOn (Online MyPadua)
  - Sora (Online MyPadua)
  - Library Physical Catalogue







# NAPLAN has moved to Term 1

- NAPLAN has moved to Term 1, so that schools will be able to receive the feedback from the tests earlier in the year and support students sooner.
- Students will complete their four (4) NAPLAN tests in Weeks 8 and 9 of Term 1.
- The skills assessed in NAPLAN, literacy and numeracy, are developed within our middle phase program; specific NAPLAN testing skills are explicitly taught throughout the term.
- Communications relating to NAPLAN will be sent out early in Term 1.



### Padua College Laptop Program

- A program that is cost efficient and sustainable whereby student laptops are provided at key learning points to support each phase of learning, (Junior, Middle & Senior). College laptop cycle
  - Years 5 & 6
  - Years 7 9
  - Years 10 12
- Covered by manufacturer's Warranty and Accidental Damage Protection (ADP).
- Retain device for 3 years, in which time it is covered for 3 ADP claims where some excesses may apply.
- Supported by College ICT Department with loan machines provided where required






### **Laptop Collection 2024**
